Job Responsibilities

Camp Nurse will be primarily responsible for the medical assessment and intervention of campers, volunteers, and staff at Cornerstone of Hope summer camp programs. This list is not meant to be an inclusive list; Camp Nurse may be asked to perform other activities while working in this position.

- Review medical history and applicable information (i.e.: allergies, immunizations) of all campers attending camp program(s)
- Hold campers' prescription medications and all over the counter medications as needed throughout entirety of camp program(s)
- Respond to requests for medical assistance, including but not limited to first aid, injuries, and illnesses
- Administer first aid to campers, staff, and volunteers present at camp program(s) as needed
- Administer medications (prescription or over the counter) as applicable
- Provide medical recommendations for treatment and follow-up care that may be required for campers, staff, and volunteers at camp program(s)
- Offer emotional support and compassionate presence to campers throughout entirety of camp program(s)
- Carry out other responsibilities as delegated
